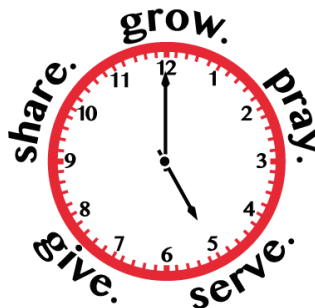

Dear Parish Family,

As called and gifted members at St. Michael Church, Poplar Springs-Mt. Airy, I welcome you to fellowship and service 2019-2020 for the glory of God and the good of the Church. At this stage of your faith journey, may you find at this sanctuary spiritual support and guidance from the word of God, prayer, the sacraments, and opportunities for spiritual and corporal works of mercy.

As pastor for nearly 31 years, I ask you, as faithful and prudent stewards over the household of faith, to support our parish family temporally, even as the pastoral and administrative staff and mission leaders strive their best to support you and your family spiritually.

Parish leaders are excited by accomplishments and plans for the future: Due to careful fiscal management, there are strong financial results this past year despite the moral scandal in the Church; the fire and booster pumps were replaced and the alarm system updated; more community involvement in support of working parents by opening a successful Preschool/Daycare; in addition, the County's approval to erect a picnic pavilion as another venue for church activities; the wonderful summer work camps, mini-camp, vacation Bible school; community support of Monday night Bingo and Cornerstone Breakfast; the hire of a full-time Director of Liturgy and Music and a part-time custodian; intentional welcoming of children; the ongoing rite of Christian initiation for children and adults, and baptism sacramental prep; the intentional promotion of church library; the growing and making disciples through *That Man Is You*, *Walking With Purpose*, Bible studies such as *Unlocking the Mystery of the Bible* and the new *ManAlive: Men Growing In Faith*; the contractual professional coaching and mentoring services of Parish Success Group (PSG) to deliver a strategic plan for engagement and growth. All these efforts require time and talent and the financial support from generous and sacrificial givers.

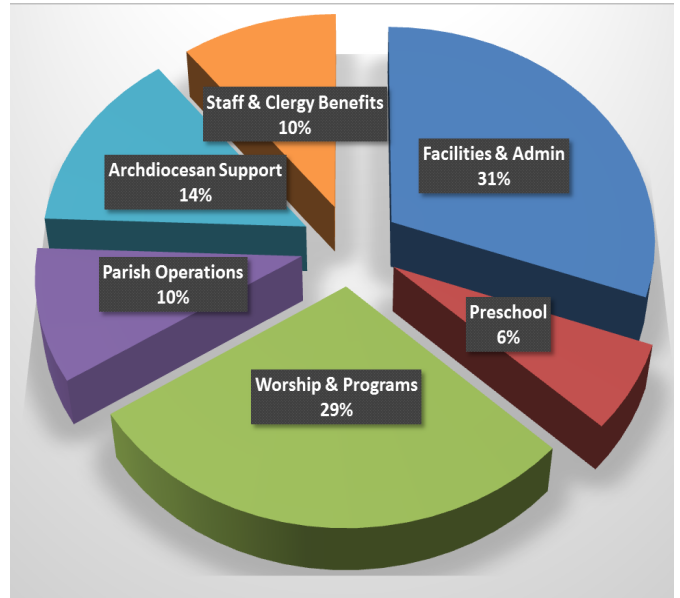

Sources of Operating Revenue

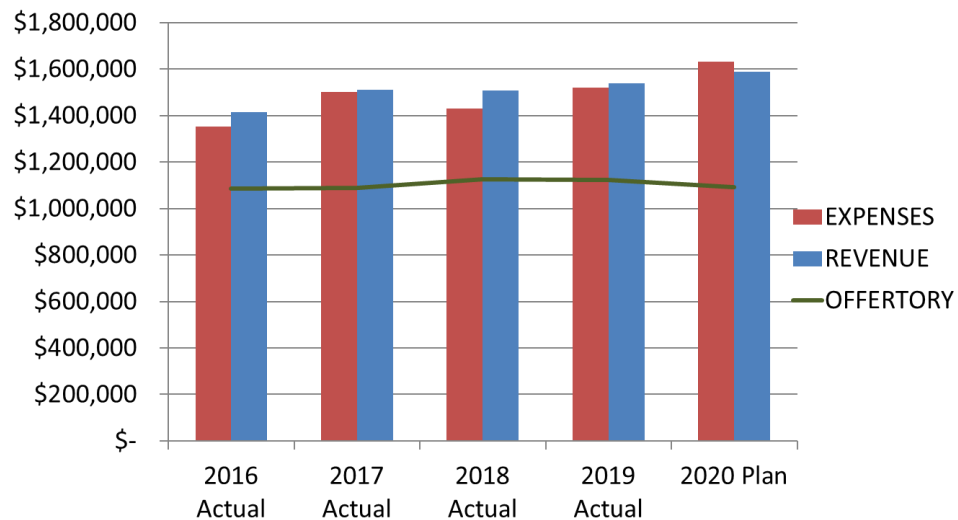


Operating Expenses



- Offertory giving through online giving and envelopes accounts for 70% of our operating income.
- To meet our 2019 budget we must sustain weekly offertory giving. We are required to keep four months of operating expenses on hand in savings. We have \$200K on hand and set a goal to grow our savings by \$300K to meet this savings requirement of \$500K.

Operating Revenue & Expenses

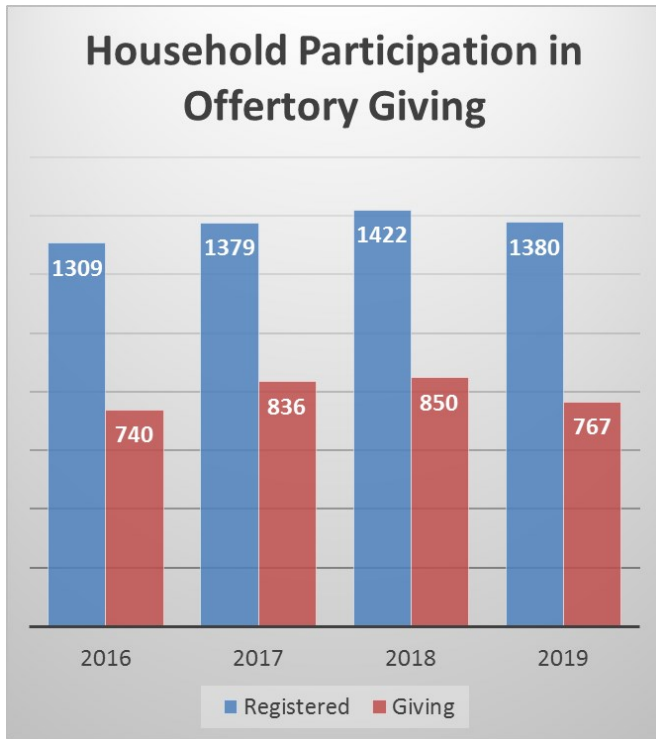

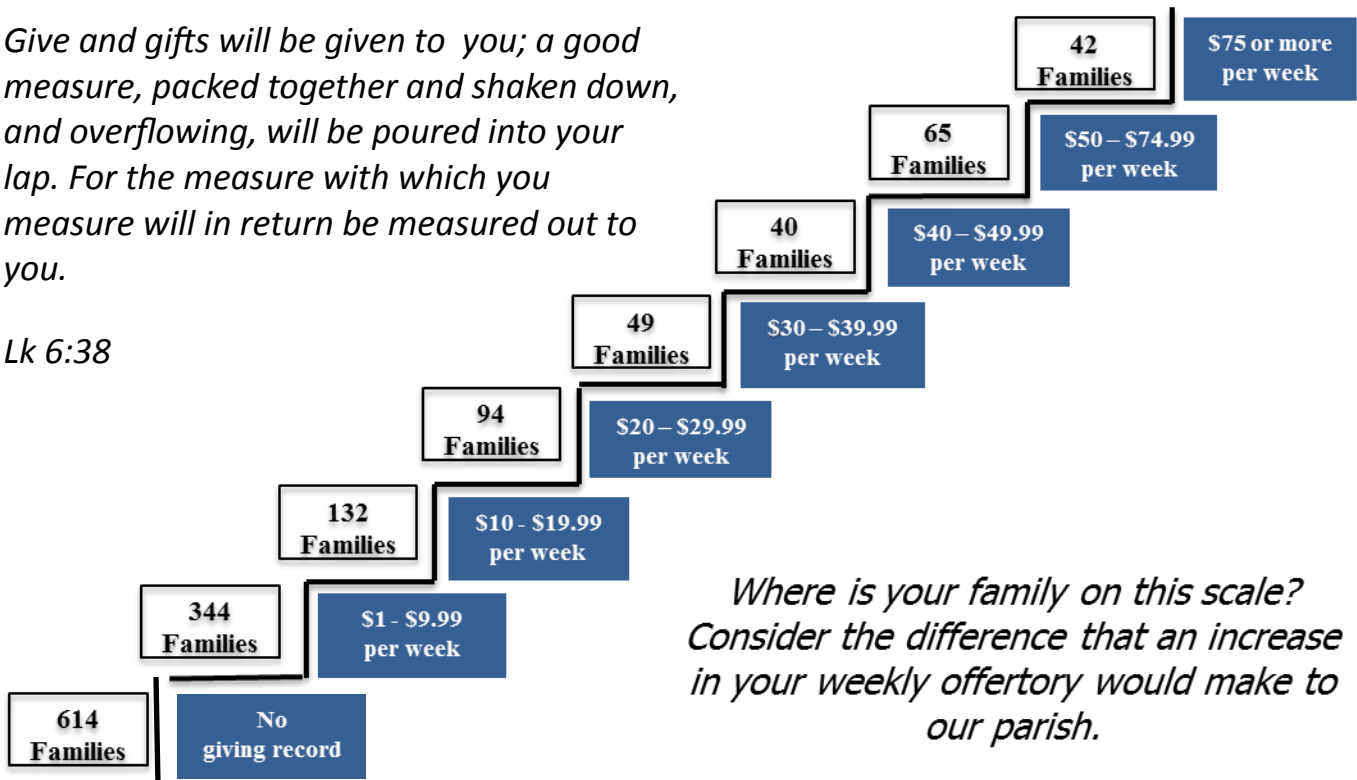

Parish Success Group...

In March of 2019, St. Michael engaged the Parish Success Group to join us for a weekend of activities, primarily to facilitate our Parish Day of Reflection on March 30th and then to attend and observe our weekend Masses. John Rinaldo D. Min. gained great insight on our parish community and we made a decision to invite PSG back for a 90 day initial phase of coaching, interviewing and consulting with our Pastor, parish staff and leaders. John returned for 2-3 day visits in June, July and August before preparing a summary report and a new proposal for an additional 9 month agreement to continue the work of guiding us to grow in our missionary discipleship. Our new contract begins in October.
