

# THE COMMEMORATION OF THE LORD'S ENTRANCE INTO JERUSALEM

After this, the priest and people sign themselves, while the Priest says, In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Then he greets the people in the usual way. A brief address is given, in which the faithful are invited to participate actively and consciously in the celebration of this day, in these or similar words."

#### **PRIEST:**

Dear brothers and sisters, since the beginning of Lent until now we have prepared our hearts by penance and charitable works.

Today we gather together
to herald with the whole Church
the beginning of the celebration
of our Lord's Paschal Mystery,
that is to say,

of his Passion and Resurrection.

For it was to accomplish this mystery that he entered his own city of Jerusalem. Therefore, with all faith and devotion,

let us commemorate the Lord's entry into the city of our salvation, following in his footsteps, so that, being made by his grace partakers of the Cross, we may have a share also in his Resurrection and in his life. After the address, the Priest says the following prayer **with hands extended**:

#### **PRIEST:**

Let us pray...
Almighty ever living God,
sanctify + these branches
with your blessing,
that we, who follow Christ the King
with exultation,
may reach the eternal Jerusalem
with him.

Who lives and reigns forever and ever. *ALL: Amen.* 

Matthew 21: 1 - 11 At the Procession with Palms - Gospel + A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew.

When Jesus and the disciples drew near Jerusalem and came to Bethphage on the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two disciples, saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find an ass tethered, and a colt with her.

Untie them and bring them here to me

Untie them and bring them here to me. And if anyone should say anything to you, reply, 'The master has need of them.' Then he will send them at once."

This happened so that what had been spoken through the prophet might be fulfilled:

Say to daughter Zion,

"Behold, your king comes to you, meek and riding on an ass,

and on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden."

The disciples went and did as Jesus had ordered them.

They brought the ass and the colt and laid their cloaks over them, and he sat upon them.

The very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches from the trees and strewed them on the road.

The crowds preceding him and those following kept crying out and saying:

"Hosanna to the Son of David;

blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; hosanna in the highest."

And when he entered Jerusalem

the whole city was shaken and asked, "Who is this?" And the crowds replied,

"This is Jesus the prophet, from Nazareth in Galilee."
